### **World Renew**

On Friday, March 6, powerful tornadoes tore through southwest Michigan, devastating the communities of Edwardsburg, Three Rivers, and Union City. Homes were torn apart. Trees crashed into buildings. Entire neighborhoods are now covered in debris where families once felt safe. Local officials report that four people lost their lives, and many others were injured.

World Renew's Disaster Response Services (DRS) team is closely monitoring the situation in Michigan and stands ready to deploy volunteers as soon as local authorities invite response organizations like ours to assist.

As spring storm season begins, severe weather is already impacting communities across North America. Our DRS team is preparing to walk alongside affected communities in Michigan and beyond in the weeks and months ahead, especially as more storms are forecasted this season.
