Seeing our neighbors...

- ✤ God emphasizes in his word our love and respect for *all* our neighbors. This includes folks who come from different backgrounds and the "foreigner living among you." (Luke 10:25-37; Ephesians 2:14-18; Leviticus 19:33-34)
- ✤ We have a growing Hispanic population in our area. For example, there are *over 80* students in McBain Public Schools who are in the special program for English Language learners (ELL).
- ✤ There are *extremely limited* opportunities for spiritual growth and worship in our area in the Spanish language.
 - There is a small group that worships in the building of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Lake City twice a month.
 - The Roman Catholic Church in Marion occasionally has a Spanish-speaking priest, but this has been only sporadic lately.

English Language Tutoring at Vogel Center CRC

- ✤ Our church is offering support for our neighbors to improve their English language ability through tutoring relationships.
 - Understanding and speaking English is one of the most important steps for successfully integrating into our community. When we ask our Spanish-speaking neighbors how we can help them, learning English is top of the list.
 - We had a successful program going in 2016, and we are resuming it.
- The goal is to serve a need but also to *build bridges* of friendships and relationships.
- ✤ We are partnering with the Literacy Council of Cadillac for training, materials, and support.
- ✤ As we resume, we are emphasizing tutoring relationships rather than classes. This means we have *plenty of opportunities* for tutors.
- ✤ The flagship time for tutors and learners to meet in *Thursday evenings from 5-7pm*. Tutors and learners are free to arrange their own meetings, but we encourage them to take advantage of the open-house format of these two hours each week.
 - We will offer light refreshments.
 - Childcare will be available for younger children.
 - Homework help will be available for older children.
 - There are lots of ways to get involved!

Ministry and church planting

- ✤ We are also looking to bring a Spanish-speaking pastor into our area as a chaplain, churchplanter, and ministry catalyst.
- This is a joint effort with all of the churches in our area, though the CRC denomination and Classis Northern Michigan would be major financial supporters.
- ✤ We have a potential pastor from Cuba who is living in Michigan as a candidate.
- ✤ We are forming a leadership team of six people who will oversee and guide his work.
- ✤ We estimate this would be about 20 hours each week.
- ✤ The goal is to develop small faith communities in homes and workplaces around our area, and possibly worship services.
