Points to Ponder to Prepare

August 2 Hebrews 3:1-6
"Greater than Moses"

One of the main themes we have already seen in the Letter to the Hebrews is the Jesus, the Son of God, is "greater than..." In chapters 1 and 2 he was greater than angels. Here in chapter 3, he is greater than Moses.

- ✝ How does the author address his audience in v. 1. Do you see yourself this way?
- ✝ What does it mean to "fix our thoughts on Jesus"? What does this look like in practice in our daily rhythms?
- ✝ Reflect on who Moses was in the story of the Jewish people and what he represented.
- ✝ What comparisons does the author make to show that Jesus is even greater than Moses?
- ✝ Look carefully at verses 3-4. Who is described as being "the builder of the house"? What does this tell us about Jesus?
- ✝ What does it mean in v. 6 that we are God's house? What condition is attached to this?
