August 17 – "I Have You in My Heart" Philippians 1:1-11

Points to Ponder to Prepare

August 24 – "It's Not About Me" Philippians 1:12-29

Sin is *self-centered*. In its proper place everything is centered around God as Lord of all. This is how we, as humans, were created also: as servants, stewards and worshippers of God. But hear the subtlety of the Serpent's lie, "You will be like God." It is an invitation to put ourselves at the center. When Adam and Eve took this invitation, everything in creation went out of kilter.

Read Philippians 1:12-29. Hear how Paul is finding his proper place again with God at the center of his life.

- → How does Paul respond to the hardships
 of being in prison? (vv. 12-14)
- → How does Paul respond when people preach the gospel in a way that is meant to hurt Paul and advance themselves? (vv. 15-18)
- [⊕] How does Paul respond to the very real possibility that he will be killed because of his ministry? (vv. 19-26)
- [⊕] How does Paul encourage us to respond to opposition and hardships? (vv. 27-30)

Hear the central theme of this week's passage: "It's not about me!"
